He was captured along with few other elephants by a group of men headed by a Muslim man named Umaru Lebbe Panikkar in November 1925, who became its Mahout (Trainer) and appears with the Tusker on the 1991 Rs 1000 currency note. Raja carried the sacred casket at the annual perahera in Kandy from 1950 to 1987 and died in July 1988. See 2004 February Story on lankaweb. In 1988 I was doing research at DAO in Victoria, Canada at the time and remember reading a headline in the "National Enquirer" saying "Sacred Elephant dies gets Stuffed". Assumed it to be typical Tabloid Fake News. Raja's stuffed remains are presently in a special museum within the grounds of the Temple of the Tooth in Kandy. Garantie die Echtheit
