The National Emblem is circular in shape; in the middle of a red background is a five-pointed gold star framed by Rice ears below which is half a cogwheel and the inscription "Socialist Republic of Vietnam". The coat of arms was designed by artist Bùi Trang Ch??c and was edited by artist Tr??n V??n C??n. The design closely resembles the emblem of the People's Republic of China, and the entire emblem is based on the coat of arms of the Soviet Union. Reverse: The One Pillar Pagoda above value, inscription "State Bank of Vietnam" around. The One Pillar Pagoda is a historic Buddhist temple in Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam. The temple was built by Emperor Lý Thái Tông, who ruled from 1028 to 1054. According to the court records, Lý Thái Tông was childless and dreamt that he met the bodhisattva Avalokiteshvara, who handed him a baby son while seated on a lotus Flower. Lý Thái Tông then married a peasant girl that he had met and she bore him a son. The emperor constructed the temple in gratitude for this in 1049, having been told by a monk named Thi??n Tu? to build the temple, by erecting a pillar in the middle of a lotus pond, similar to the one he saw in the Dream. The temple is built of wood on a single stone pillar 1.25 m in diameter, and it is designed to resemble a lotus blossom, which is a Buddhist symbol of purity, since a lotus blossoms in a muddy pond. In 1954, the French Union forces destroyed the pagoda before withdrawing from Vietnam after the First Indochina War. It was rebuilt afterwards. 2003, Mint of Finland. Auflagen: Mintage = 125 000 000.
